GIFT AID: EXPLANATORY NOTES

Under the Gift Aid scheme, any amount donated to a registered charity qualifies for tax relief provided you have paid tax (whether income tax or capital gains tax) at least equal to the amount of tax due to be recovered from the Inland Revenue. Tax at the basic rate of 20% can be recovered by FaRiG from HMRC. If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HMRC to adjust your tax code.
